CLINICAL RESEARCH

IMPACT: Providing Relief From Chronic Rhinosinusitis in Cystic Fibrosis

The work of CHEST grant recipient Shahid Sheikh, MD, and his colleagues—published in *JAMA Otolaryngology – Head & Neck Surgery*—revealed a positive impact of elexacaftor-tezacaftor-ivacaftor on chronic rhinosinusitis in patients with cystic fibrosis (CF). Their work also showed that their CF-specific Sheikh-Lind sinus CT scoring system is as good as the gold-standard Lund-Mackay scoring system in quantifying both extent of sinus disease and response to therapy.

COMMUNITY IMPACT

IMPACT: Supporting the Local Community in Hawai'i

A new CHEST venture at the annual meeting in Honolulu emphasized meaningful engagement with local communities. Donor funding made it possible for CHEST to host a booth focused on pediatric and youth asthma awareness and prevention at the Wai'anae Farmers' Market. In addition to providing educational guidance, volunteers distributed 200 free masks and spacers to the community.

IMPACT: Improving Diversity in Respiratory Care
